

THE STORY OF AN IDEA



BY EVENING THE PLAIN IS STREWN WITH THOUSANDS OF WOUNDED, DVING AND DEAD SOLDIERS.





IN 1863 THE IDEA BECOMES REALITY. HENRY DUNANT, TOGETHER WITH FOUR OTHER GTIZENS OF GENEVA, CREATES THE INTERNATIONAL COMMITTEE FOR AID TO THE WOUNDED, LATER TO BECOME

IN 1864 A DIPLOMATIC CONFERENCE ADOPTS A FIRST GENEVA CONVENTION FOR THE AMELIORATION OF THE CONDITION OF THE


